SPOTLIGHT: 'MESSY PLAY'

Each month, we are going to shine the spotlight on an area of our church and give you an insight to the life of St Andrews. This month is 'Messy Play' our parent/carer toddler group.

Messy Play started up on Wednesday 13th September as a replacement to 'Stay n Play' which had been running for six years. The group is already getting approximately 20 children a week. Here's what some parents had to say:

"Absolute freedom for the children in a safe environment, a very different type of group"

"Absolutely love messy play, different things every week, helping to socialise. It's never boring and we are never judged on our situations."

"A lovely change of scenery, the children love the different textures and making friendships. It is a very different environment and there is fantastic support from the leaders"

"The freedom the children have to explore the sensory play and they are not afraid to squeeze and feel the mess. They are forming new friends and are willing to be independent and share. All children can find something to play with. As a childminder, it is wonderful to have amazing support if having a bad day."

June Stocker and Julie-Ann Ward have been leading the group and are extremely pleased with the feedback and support they are getting each week. Messy Play is on each Wednesday morning during term time for children aged birth – four years and their parents/carers.

INCOME

Currently our offering is slightly ahead of this point last year. We shared earlier this year through our stewardship appeal, setting out the vision and aims for 2017, in which our offering budget significantly increased. This was to ensure we secured funds to support the ministry, mission and maintenance of the church and ensure we can fund the full time Business Administrator. This role is vital to the function of the church and we are very grateful for all offerings/tithing either through the offering bag or by standing order. Please prayerful consider our giving. Hall hire and general donations are currently above budget.

Our net income at 31st September 2017 is £56,561 which is £10,809 behind budget.

EXPENDITURE

We have had additional expenditure following the new manse kitchen. We have completed the main installation the walls and floor are still to be completed.

Overall however expenditure is underspent, which has certainly helped our overall budget. Our net expenditure at 31st September 2017 is £54,677 which is £6,071 behind budget
